




42 % of all students in German TNB projects are at GUC





- Application: May 2018
- Approved: 13.08.2018
- Duration: 01.01.2019 - 31.12.2022
- First project phase:
 - Call for proposals: 15.10.2018
 - Submission deadline: 15.11.2018
 - Decision: 15.12.2018
 - Start of projects: 01.01.2019
 - Submissions: 37
- Title: “German University in Cairo (GUC): Towards excellence and international visibility in research and teaching”
 - Goal: Support GUC to establish a sustainable quality and visibility of education and research together with German partners
 - Four strategic instruments to achieve this goal

Phase V – Instrument 1 – Research Clusters

Modules:

- **Matchmaking-Workshops, Research Stays, Proposal-/Output-Workshops, Summer Schools, Proposal Writing Training**

Exemplary structure of research clusters:

- Phase I: **Contact Phase** (1 Year)



- Phase II: **Establish funded Research Projects** (2 Years)



- Phase I should involve larger groups of researchers (whole faculties or departments) while Phase II should be more focussed

Research Clusters: Targeting ambitious Funding Opportunities

- 1. DFG Cooperation with Developing Countries**
- 2. DFG-STDF Memorandum of Understanding**
- 3. STDF/BMBF German Egyptian Research Fund (GERF)**
- 4. EU Research, Development and Innovation Programme in Egypt (RDI)**
- 5. DAAD Hochschuldialog mit der Islamischen Welt**

Phase V – Instrument 2 – Joint PhDs

- Not part of funding, but coupled
- New sandwich concept: 1-2-1 or 1-1-1-1
 - Half of PhD time in Germany
 - Should be embedded into research clusters

Phase V – Instrument 3 – Research Hub for MENA-Region

- Identification of Research clusters and focal topics
- Goal: Establish GUC as research hub for those topics in MENA-region and as a gateway to Germany and Europe
- Support summer schools, international research workshops and conferences to be organized at GUC
 - Invitation of speakers
 - Travel grants

Phase V – Instrument 4 – Quality Assurance

- Continue to support GUC in ist development of curricula and in acceditation processes
- Train teaching staff at GUC in didactics of higher education
